## CHILD EDUCATION SPONSORSHIP PROGRAMME

The objective of the child sponsorship programme is to ensure the holistic development of the child which enables them to become self-reliant through education, timely guidance and motivation, in spite of their poor socio-economic background. Child sponsorship programme is to ensure that the child continues to stay with his/her family of any sort (either with parents or other relatives or in foster care) and is NEVER institutionalized. For a better future, sponsorship programme reaches out to deserving children. **Rajagiri outREACH is supporting 2862 children from all over Kerala.**

### 1 Educational Kit/Sponsorship Aid Distribution

With the support of the Development Committees of the concerned area, School kits (bags, books, umbrellas etc) were distributed to 2862 sponsored students at 26 centers. The distribution was carried out in the months of May & June 2017. MLA's, LSG representatives, Corporate Heads and Various NGO representatives were present in the functions.

## HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME

The Higher education assistance programme of Rajagiri outREACH supports the students from underprivileged families who are doing professional education. The major sponsors of the program are Kinder for Kinder, Sri Ramunni Paniker Udbodhan Trust, Rajan and Grace Foundation and Sud Chemie India PVT.LTD. During this period Higher Education scholarship were distributed to students those who are studying for B.Tech, (IT, CSE, EC) BSC Nursing, MBBS, MBA, Polytechnic, B.Ed etc. A total of Rupees 13, 80,000(Thirteen LakhEighty Thousand Rupees) were distributed to 161 students.

## LAUNCHING OF KAVAL PROJECT

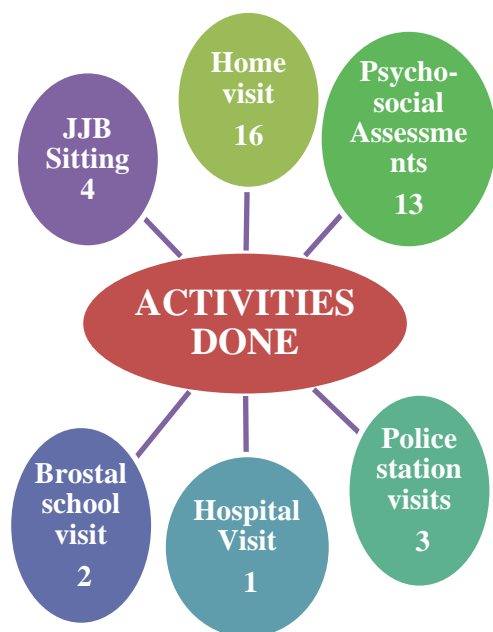

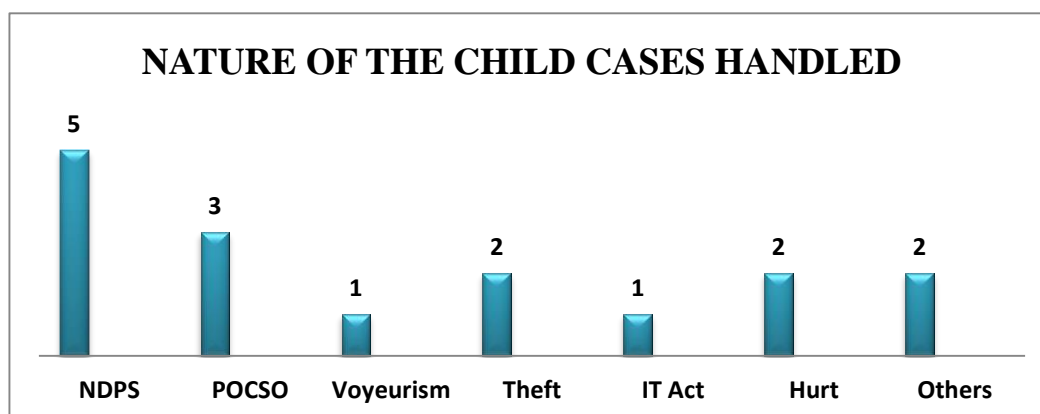

Chittilapilly Foundation, K.P.Paul Foundation, KITCO Ltd. and Sud Chemie Ltd. The women are provided with skill training on tailoring, handicrafts making, catering service, book binding, jewellery making, cow/goat rearing, poultry farm, beauty parlour, flour mill, mobile eatery shop, soap making, organic farming etc. Terre Des Home, Denmark also has been given assistance for 2 Women Self Help Groups at Arattupuzha in Alapuzha district and Edavanakkad in Ernakulam district, the Tsunami affected villages in Kerala. The programme would enable the women to be economically independent and self reliant. The experience in the field of women entrepreneurship projects proves that the programme is the need of the hour in rural areas as well as in urban areas for the development of women and thus to strengthen the family. In addition to the skill training, the women were provided with training on book keeping and accounts, capacity building, public relation, communication skill and team management. Through the training we could motivate them to bring out their inborn skills and use it in a better way to get an earning for their day to day life. Some of them could accommodate other unemployed women into their enterprise. It is worth mentioning that the programmes boost up the self-confidence of the women beneficiaries which enable them to get more acceptances in the family as well as in the community.

### 1 CSR PROGRAMME OF KITCO LTD.

#### Tribal Women Entrepreneurship Project at Kuttampuzha, Ernakulam District

KITCO Ltd, one of the premier engineering, management consultancy firms in India joined hands with Rajagiri outREACH in women empowerment programme. A tribal women entrepreneurship project has been launched under the CSR initiative by KITCO Ltd. in 3 Tribal Villages at Kuttampuzha Grama Panchayath in Ernakulam district for Apiculture and Bamboo Handicraft items. 30 tribal women beneficiaries were selected from 3 hamlets for the implementation of the projects. The project visualizes the sustainability of livelihood activities of tribal women in the target area through marketing and value addition of products. Tribal promoters training also included in the project of KITCO. The project launching was held on 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2016 at Kuttampuzha. The beneficiaries were given hamlet based and class room training on reed craft and apiculture by the experts. The beneficiaries appeared for the Artisans Test by the Central Govt. and 29 of them qualified. They attended different melas and 80% of their products were sold through these trade fairs. The beneficiaries had the opportunity to interact with the community residing outside of their hamlet by participating in the melas and exhibitions. The programme certainly did act as a platform to bring them to the main stream of the society which was a significant need of a tribal women community. During this period, monthly review meetings and awareness classes, seasonal management work of apiculture were conducted.

Recognizing the efforts of the tribal women from Kuttampuzha, the beneficiaries of KITCO project were awarded artisan certificate on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2017. The 29 tribal women beneficiaries received artisan certificate issued by Ministry of Textiles, Government of India. The certificate was distributed by Mr. Cyriac Davis, Managing Director, KITCO, secretary Kuttampuzha Grama Panchayath and Project Director, RAJAGIRI outREACH.

It is a new initiative to start the women empowerment programme at Njarackal and Kunnathunadu Grama Panchayath, Ernakulam district by K. Chittilappilly Foundation. 25 beneficiaries from Njarackal Grama Panchayath and 10 beneficiaries from Kunnathunadu Grama Panchayath were selected through house visits and interviews. # PROGRAMMES FOR ELDERLY



## ➤ Geriatric Care

‘Day Care Centre for the Elderly’ named “Pakalveedu” is one of the major interventions of Rajagiri outREACH. Pakalveedu functioning with the support of various Corporates, LSG’s, clubs, organizations etc.

The Day Care Centre for Elderly is a non-institutional scheme namely Pakalveedu for the elderly mainly functioning in Ernakulam District. The emphasis is on non -institutional and Community Based Services (CBS) with the intention of integrating the elderly with the community. The purpose and basic principle of the approach is to help the elderly who experience isolation, negligence and suffer from insecurity, anxiety and depression. The programme supports 200 elderly people through different centers. The activities of the day care includes News Paper reading, Discussion on local reports, Personal Sharing, Feature films shown on elders issues, Games and Yoga, Counseling and Awareness classes on health, relationships etc., Celebration of members Birthdays, Nutritious lunch, Observation of occasions like Elders Day, Gandhi Jayanthi, Onam, Christmas are part of programmes /activities organized there. The service of a doctor once a week is provided at certain centers. As part of the awareness programme provided by the Organization to nearby Colleges and Schools on Day care of Elderly, the students of these Institutions started visiting the Organization as a full day programme which includes the distribution of sweets, cultural programmes, games etc. The social workers from Rajagiri outREACH pay visit to pakalveedu on a regular basis to provide support for the functioning.

Our first Senior Citizen Center (Pakalveedu) was established in Kothad village in the year 1997. Pakalveedu later has been established in 11 different villages spread around Kerala, including one at Red Cross Bhavan of the Indian Red Cross Society, Kakkanad. Currently the centers are functioning at Kothad, Kadamakudy, and Binanipuram.

- ✓ Gathering together on every Tuesdays & Fridays and having meals jointly.
- ✓ Regular Health Check Ups, Medical Camps and Awareness sessions held by Doctors.
- ✓ Outings taken within Kerala with the aim of relaxation.

- ✓ Cultural programmes /events are organized annually with entertainments.

## ➤ Vayovandhanam

## JALANIDHI PROJECT

Jalanidhi is an integrated water supply and sanitation project undertaken by government of Kerala, implemented by Kerala Rural Water Supply and Sanitation Agency (K.R.W.S.A) with the financial assistance of World Bank. The project is being implemented in selected Grama Panchayaths (GPs) with effective community participation. The key stake holders in the project are Grama Panchayath (GP), Beneficiary Group (BG), Supporting Organization(SO) and the KRWSA with a unique cost sharing system. The supporting organization has a vital role in implementation of the project. Rajagiri is empanelled as a supporting organization of Jalanidhi Project. As an empanelled agency Rajagiri,outREACH Kalamassery has implemented Jalanidhi projects in two Grama Panchayaths i.e.



Kunnamthanam Grama Panchayath in Pathanamthitta district and Arakkulam Grama Panchayath in Idukki District. As part of the project implementation, in these Grama Panchayaths, supporting organization is providing Community Development and Technical Assistance to the BGs as well as conducting Grama Sabhas, Training Programs, Water Day and Environment Day Programs, Women Empowerment Programs, GP Level Ground Water Recharging Programs etc.

✓ **Kunnamthanam Grama Panchayath, Pathanamthitta District**

Kunnamthanam Grama Panchayath in Pathanamthitta district, Mallappally block, having an area of 17.57 km<sup>2</sup> with a population of 18489. Rajagiri Outreach the Supporting Organization implemented the project through 29 small Water Supply Schemes and 2 dropped schemes. Through 27 commissioned schemes, it was started supplying drinking water to 1553 families across the GP in the peak summer of 2015, i.e. month of March onwards. All the 27 Water Supply Schemes are functioning properly as directed by the KRWSA, and now 29 schemes are exited from KRWSA (including 2 dropped schemes) and functioning as independent beneficiary groups. During this financial year, 29 BG'S has been exited from Jananidhi (KRWSA), 27 schemes now exited from GP, and the final procedure i.e. GP Audit, is under process. It is expected to conclude the project by obtaining the final exit order from the GP secretary on 2018 June itself.

✓ **Arakkulam Grama Panchayath, Idukki District**

Arakkulam Grama Panchayath in Idukki district is 16 kms from Thodupuzha, is enriched with Kanjar River, Moolamattom Hydro Electric Project, Elappally Waterfalls, Triveni Sangam etc. the Panchayath is also classified as Tribal Panchayath according to Jananidhi. Rajagiri Outreach, the Supporting Organization has implemented 35 small Water Supply Schemes and providing drinking water to 2202 families across the Panchayath including 670 exclusively ST families. As part of the project, many training programmes, awareness meeting were conducted for the upliftment of ST families. Through outstanding 23 schemes, team had completed civil works in the reporting year making all 35 schemes operational and started the drinking water supply. Among the total 35 schemes, 10 schemes have been exited from KRWSA, 12 schemes have done the final audit, expecting to conclude the project on June 2018. Support Organization has now successfully completed 6 milestones and received 6th milestone payment of Rs 12, 65, 000/-.

The two Jalanidhi GP'S i.e. Arakkulam and Kunnamthanam are now successfully distributing drinking water to project beneficiaries.

Ltd and received an additional income of Rs. 97,500/-

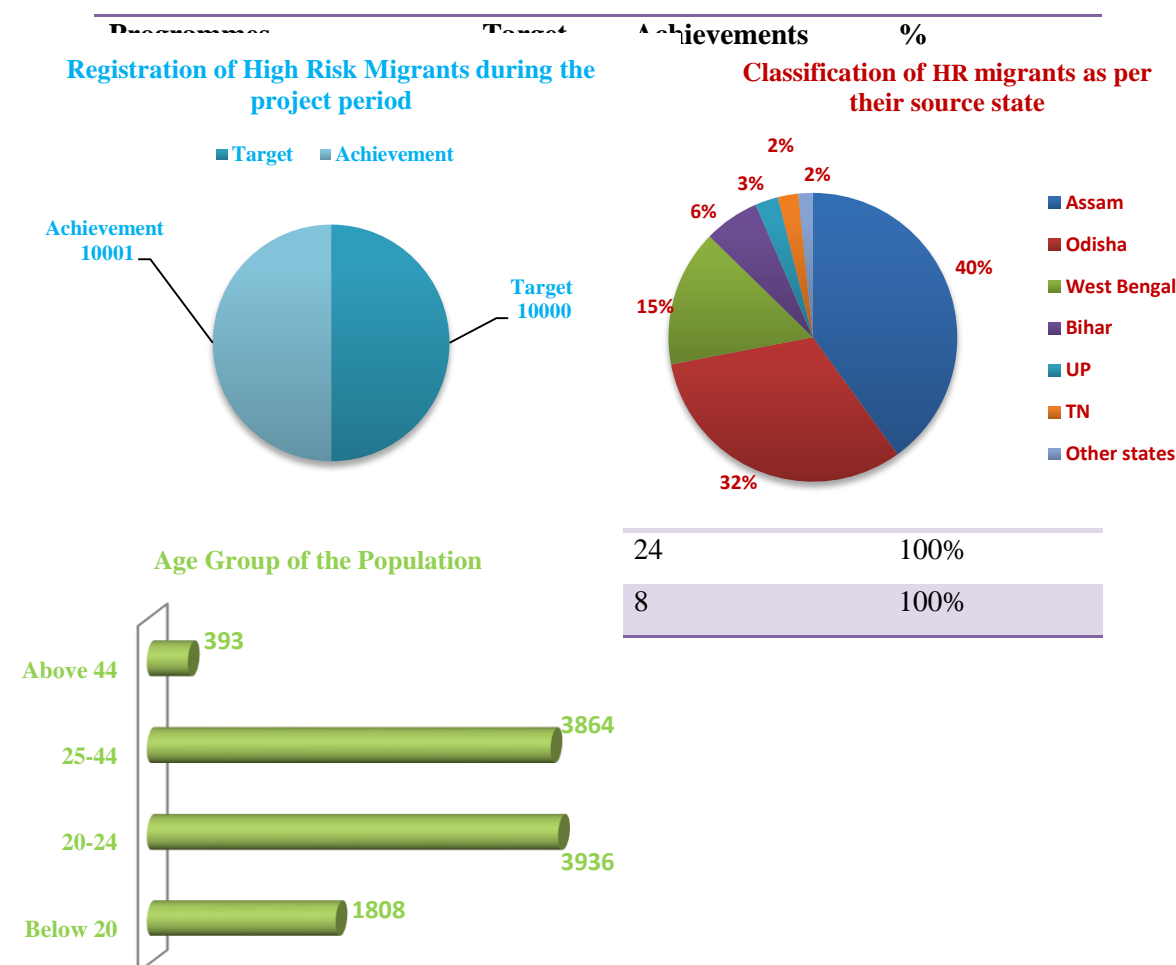

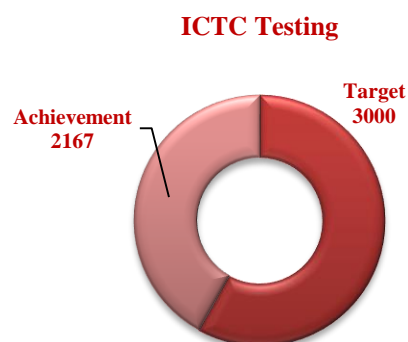
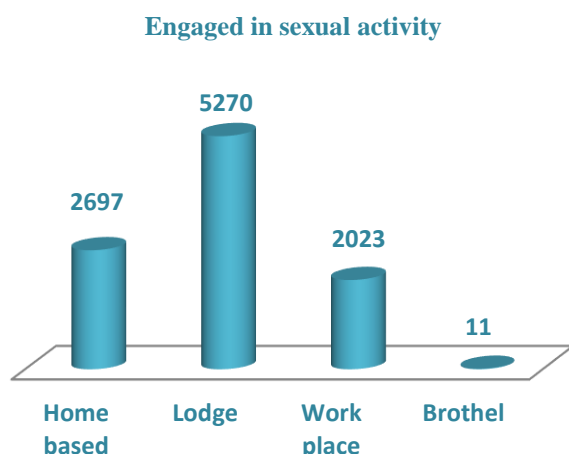


During the rapid assessment, we found that the general migrant population in perumbavoor area is around 50000 to 1, 00,000. This is estimated through a rapid estimate in the area among the local people. Mobility makes the migrants more vulnerable, also lack of sexual awareness and lack of supporting services lead the migrants to infect STI/RTI and HIV/AIDS. The site wise population distribution in Perumbavoor Project area includes Perumbavoor Municipality (above 50,000), Ramamangalam Panchayath (above 30,000), Vazhakkulam Panchayath (above 33000), Vengola Panchayath (above 10,000), and Koovappady, Okkal and Kalady Panchayath (35,000). During the reporting period we could identify 17 HIV positive cases and 11 of them registered in the ART.



### Condom Programming

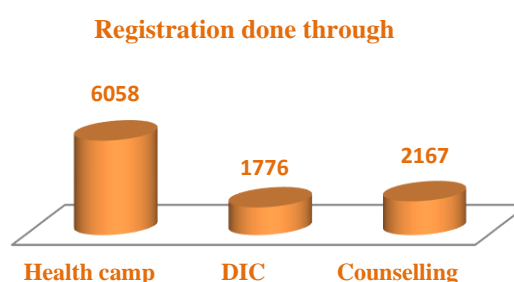
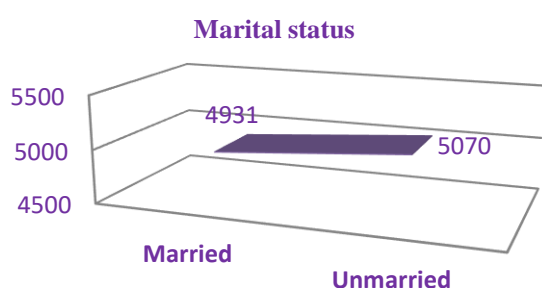
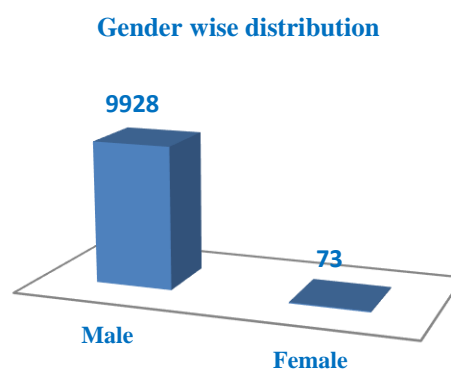
As the main objective of TI is condom promotion among migrants, we created 50 outlets in our target area within the accessibility of our population. Outlets include both traditional and nontraditional, where traditional includes medical shops and nontraditional includes petty shop, theatre, their work place, mobile shop, pan shop etc. In each outlet there will be an in charge like Voluntary peer leader company supervisor shop keepers and so on. ORW provides the condom as per their demand. In the context of fund shortage, TI could conduct sponsored camps, STI clinics and allied services under the sponsorship of various employers, builders and secondary stakeholders. 4680 condoms distributed through the Peer Leaders and through the 50 outlets.



## Advocacy and Networking

Advocacy meetings are arranged among the stake holders for the successful running of the project. The meeting includes Panchayath president, Health standing committee chairman, Ward counselors, Saw mill association representatives, contractors and supervisors of companies etc and during the time we had conducted 4 advocacy meetings in our project area.
